Our plan is to have motivational speakers who will encourage you spiritually, breakout groups and special classes to build your practice.

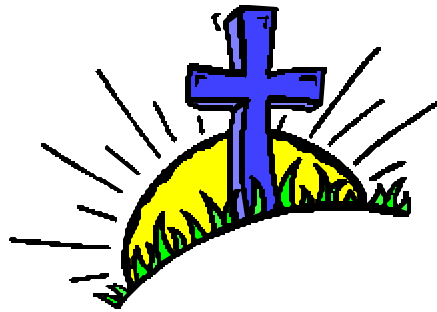
We also will introduce the new updated Bible-Based Workbook and much more.

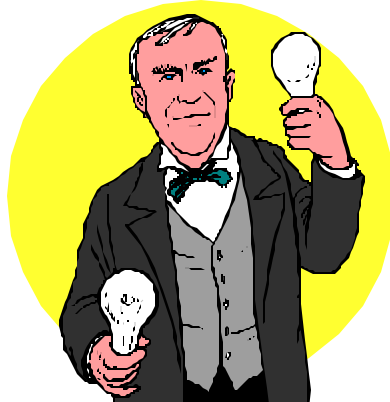
How Dreams became reality

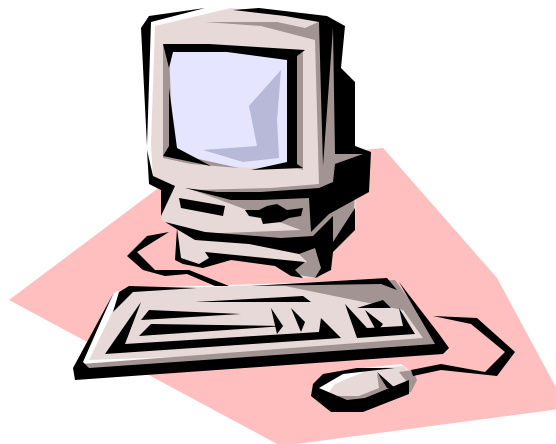
How Dreams become reality cont...
